INFRACTION

PENALTY

Destruction or Theft

Restitution for damages AND suspension for not less than one (1) tournament.

Use of Illegal Drugs
and for Alcoholic Beverages

Indefinite Suspension

Local Law Enforcement Officers will be called. Juniors may be subject to arrest

Fighting

Suspension for not less than two (2) tournaments.

Local Law Enforcement Officers will be called. Juniors may be subject to arrest.

“Boom Boxes”, radios, etc.
ARE NOT to be played in
public domain (Halls, lobbies, etc.)

Confiscation until departure

Curfew

Suspension for not less than one (1) tournament.

Local Law Enforcement Officers may be called. Juniors may be subject to arrest.

If there are any damages to individual rooms, the guilty parties will pay for the damages. Additionally, the guilty parties will be suspended from the CRJT for not less than one (1) tournament. Also, if there are any general damages in the hotel and the guilty parties CANNOT be determined, the cost will be divided among the Senates lodging at the hotel. If restitution is not made, the groups involved will be suspended until such time as payment is made. The CRJT Committee reserves all rights and any decisions rendered will be final.
