**ENTRY FORM AND RULES ON BACK**

**TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**(Failure To Read Is No Excuse)**

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** - Open to all 2011-2012 TNBA members who are certified by USBC. Senior Bowlers (Men and Women) must be at least 55 years or old. **No temporary receipts will be accepted(unless they can be verified).** No cards sold at tournament site, and cards must be presented at check-in. Management and employees of **FREEWAY LANES OF WICKLIFFE** are not eligible to bowl in this Classic.
2. **Entry Closing Date** – All entries must be fully paid to the Tournament Director by February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011 or the first 252 men & 140 women 18 years and older and 112 seniors **55** years and older. All completed entries must be accompanied by certified check or money order. **(NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED).** Walk-in Entries will be accepted up until 6am for men and 10am, for women and seniors on February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2011, providing spots are available. If less than 252 Men, 140 women and 112 seniors enter, prize fund will only be reduced by the prize fees of the number not participating.
3. **CANCELATION POLICY:** A refund minus \$10.00 processing fee will be made for cancellations made prior to 72 hours of the start of the tournament. There will be **NO REFUNDS** without a replacement with-in 72 hours of the tournament minus a \$10.00 processing fee.  
**THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR NO SHOWS.**
4. **TOURNAMENT FORMAT:**
  - a) Men and Women will bowl two (2) five (5) game blocks. Seniors two (2) four (4) game block.
  - b) Field is then cut 50%. Based on highest pinfall for ten (10) games. Seniors based on eight (8) games. The remaining Men and Women will bowl a five (5) game block. The remaining Seniors will bowl a four (4) game block.
  - c) The field is then cut to the money round 34 men, 20 women and 16 seniors. (Based on Entries), highest scores based on 252 men, 140 women and 112 seniors. The men and women will bowl a four (4) game block. Seniors will bowl a three (3) game block.
  - d) The cut to the top five (5) bowlers, who are finalist, will be determined by the total pinfall for nineteen (19) games for men and women, fifteen (15) games for seniors. These bowlers will play stair-step position, starting with the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) place bowler, who plays the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) place bowler etc.
  - e) The final roll-off game between the top two (2) finalists in each division, for the championship, will be bowled on a neutral pair of lanes.
  - f) In case of a tie for first place, there will be two (2) additional frames 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frames bowled until the tie is broken. This rule also applies for all ties in the money rounds. **In event of a tie for the 1<sup>st</sup> cut score, all bowlers with the same score will advance to the next round. (This applies to the 1<sup>st</sup> cut only!).**
5. **DRESS CODE:** All entrants are **REQUIRED** to wear shirt/blouses with participants name on the back. **Tank tops, halter tops, or tee-shirts are not allowed. No jeans or denim material (of any color), sweats, spandex (pants/skirts) will be allowed. Only women bowlers may wear walking shorts/skirts (shorts/skirts cannot be more than 3" above the knee). Bowlers may not wear headgear of any kind. There will be a \$25.00 fee per squad for any infraction of this rule.**  
**THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.**
6. **PROFESSIONAL BOWLERS:** Current PBA or Senior PBA members regardless of classification will not be permitted to bowl in TNBA Tournaments. **Past PBA/PWBA/Senior PBA champions regardless of classification, may be permitted to bowl if their championship was not within the last 10 years.** Former PBA/PWBA/Senior PBA members who have not held a card for the past two (2) years are eligible to bowl in TNBA tournaments.
7. Prize fund will be paid 100%. Prize fund will be at least one (1) prize for every eight (8) entries.
8. **Any bowler who qualifies for total winnings of \$600.00 or more in the tournament must provide a tax identification number to receive awarded prize(s).**
9. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto or there from; fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of Freeway Lanes of Wickliffe shall cause the foregoing prize schedule to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled.
10. All rules not stated above will be governed by TNBA and USBC rules.
11. Anyone employed by Freeway Lanes in Wickliffe from January 1, 2011 until the end of the tournament is not eligible to participate.
12. In the event any bowler fails to report on time, the Director reserves the right to replace him with another bowler to complete the field, only at the start of the tournament.
13. The Tournament Committee will make all decisions and reserves the right to refuse or reject any entry.
